

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ROSSER
BY-LAW NO. 11-14

Being a By-law to set reduced-speed school zone within the municipality

WHEREAS Section 98.1 of the Highway Traffic Act and the Reduced-Speed School Zones Regulation No. 136/2013 authorize a council to pass by-laws establishing the reduced maximum permitted speed for vehicles being driven on a highway within a school zone within the geographic boundaries of a municipality; and

AND WHEREAS the Council of Rural Municipality of Rosser deems it advisable and in the best interests of the *Municipality* to establish school zones with a reduced maximum speed for vehicles;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Rosser enacts as a by-law the following:

1. Interpretation

1.1 For the purposes of this By-law, “highway”, “reduced-speed school zone”, “school”, “school property”, “traffic control device”, and “vehicle” have the same meanings as set out in the Highway Traffic Act and the Reduced-Speed School Zones Regulation No. 136/2013.

2. Establishment of reduced-speed school zones

2.1 That the reduced speed limit for motor vehicles as identified below, pertain to the traveled portion of highway within 150 meters along the highway in either direction beyond the limits of the land used for purpose of the school as a school zone during times as specified.

School	Highway	Traveled Portion	Speed Limit	Prescribed Times
Rosser Elementary	PR 221	That portion of PR 221 beginning 150 metres east and west of the Rosser Elementary School property located at 0 028E PR 221	30 km/hr	September – June Monday – Friday 7:00 a.m. – 5:30 p.m.
Grosse Isle School	PR 321	That portion of PR 321 beginning 150 metres east and west of the Grosse Isle School property located at 0 097E PR 321	30 km/hr	September – June Monday – Friday 7:00 a.m. – 5:30 p.m.

3. Traffic control devices

3.1 The Municipality shall identify a reduced-speed school zone with traffic control devices that comply with the Reduced-Speed School Zones Regulation No. 136/2013.
