THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ROSSER BY-LAW No. 4-19

Being a By-Law to Open and Name a Municipal Road

WHEREAS a municipality has the direction, control and management of municipal roads within its boundary pursuant to section 287 of the Municipal Act:

Control of municipal roads

Subject to this and any other Act, a municipality has the direction, control and management of municipal roads within its boundaries.

AND WHEREAS pursuant to section 288(a) of the Municipal Act a municipality has the power to open a municipal road:

Powers respecting municipal roads

288 A municipality may

(a) subject to section 289, open a municipal road;

AND WHEREAS section 289 of *The Municipal Act* states that a municipality may open land for public use as a municipal road by passing a by-law opening the road and registering the by-law and plan with the Land Titles office:

Opening a municipal road

A municipality may open land for public use as a municipal road by

- (a) passing a by-law opening the road; and
- (b) registering the by-law and a plan at the appropriate land titles office.

AND WHEREAS section 232(1)(d) of the Municipal Act provides that:

232(1) A council may pass by-laws for municipal purposes respecting the following matters:

(d) municipal roads, including naming the roads, posting the names on public or private property, and numbering lots and buildings along the roads;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and desirable to open a municipal road over, upon and across the lands hereinafter described;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to name the road;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Rosser enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** a municipal road be and hereby opened and established over, upon and across the lands described as follows:

All that portion of the municipal road shown on a Deposit No. 39-2019 prepared by Al Degner, Manitoba Land Surveyor, on the 20th and 21st day of December 2018, and sworn to by him on the 3rd day of April, 2019

And the said lands are hereby dedicated to the public for that purposes.

2. **THAT** the said plan of survey is hereby adopted and approved, and the Chief Administrative Officer is authorized and directed to endorse the aforementioned plan of survey for identification, placing thereon his signature, under the corporate seal of the municipality, together with a reference to this By-Law.

3. **THAT** the municipal road opened and established over, upon and across the lands set out in Deposit No. 39-2019 is hereby named Brookside Boulevard.
